



# YouKnow – How to Play

Download the YouKnow app from Play Store or App Store.

In app: Set «My Language» (your mother tongue, or the language you understand best in the list) under Settings.

## GAME RULES

The most important rule in YouKnow™ is: Say It to Play It!

Play a card with same colour or number as the card on top of the stack on the table. Except when there's a Special Card on top — then you are free to play whichever card you'd like. And remember to always say what's pictured on the card. Say It to Play It!

If you can't play any card, draw 1—3 cards, until you are able to play — or have to pass.

If you can play a card, but don't know the term pictured on the card, then put it down for the other players to see it. Either they can tell you the correct term, or you can scan the card's QR code to get the term. As you haven't been able to say the card, you will have to take back the card + 1 extra card from the stack on the table. Same goes if you say the wrong term for the card. Remember it next time!

The player who gets rid of all his/her cards first, wins. (But the real winner is the player who's improved the most...)

## SPECIAL CARDS

There are 4 Special Cards in YouKnow™. Note: You are not allowed to play a Special Card on your last round.

## GIFT CARD

When you play the Gift Card, you can give away any of your cards to a player of your choice.

## PLUS 2 CARD

When you play the Plus 2 Card, the next player has to draw 2 cards from the deck on the table. That player still gets to play his/her turn.

## SCAN CARD

When you play the scan card, you get to scan a card on your hand. Or you can choose to play it as a Plus 1 Card instead, for the next player to draw 1 card from the deck on the table.

## CHALLENGE CARD

When you play the Challenge Card, you get to play yet another «normal» card, and the next player has to say that card. Or he/she will have to scan the card, take it and draw 1 extra card from the deck. He/she still gets to play his/her turn. The Challenge Card lasts for one whole round, where the next player will have to say the card the previous player has played. Players can play any non-Special Card on the Challenge round, regardless of colour or number.
